



Instruction to **Selected Participants**

PRESENTATION OF REPORT OF THE PROJECTS:

- The selected students will be intimated to submit TWO hard copies of detailed Project Report in about 18 pages (Times New Roman /Font 12/A4 sheets).
- One copy is for presentation (display) in science fair and the other copy should be submitted at the time of registration in person.
- A soft copy of the report should be emailed to the Organizing Secretary (aalimnsf2017@gmail.com) on or before 2nd Jan, 2017.

The project report should be prepared under the following headings:

- Selection of the problem/Statement of the problem
- Formulation of hypothesis
- Related studies (in brief)
- Sampling
- Experiments/Observation / Collection of data (in detail)
- Results and Discussion/Testing of Hypothesis
- Conclusion of the study
- References
- Acknowledgement

DISPLAY OF PROJECTS IN NATIONAL SCIENCE FAIR (NSF- 2017)

- A report consisting of 18 pages of the data and summary of the projects shall be displayed on the cardboard or thermocol (three boards of 3'x 2' dimension) attached to each other.
- Each board arranged vertically should contain only SIX A4 Sheets for a symmetric arrangement (18 in total). A4 sheets with Yellow back ground, typed in black or other colors with different font size and style (not exceeding 18 pages in total) as specified below.

Running text 14 point

• Font Style : Times New Roman

• Maximum No. of pages

Allowed for Report Display : 18 only (A4 SIZE)
