Title of the Practice: Motivating students towards social awareness and responsibilities through NSS

Objectives of the Practice:

The Context:

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunity to the student youth in college level of India to take part in various government led community service activities & programmes. The sole aim of the NSS is to provide hands on experience to young students in delivering community service. Since inception of the NSS in the year 1969, the number of students in various universities, colleges and Institutions of higher learning have volunteered to take part in various community service programmes. The motto or watchword of the NSS is “Not me but you”. It underlines that the welfare of an individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of society on the whole. This expresses the essence of democratic living and upholds the need of selfless service and appreciation of the other man’s point of view and also consideration for fellow human beings.

The Practice:

Students undertake various need-based program in the adopted villages, college campuses and urban slums during weekends or after college hours. 120 hours per year and 240 hours for 2 consecutive years. Seven days camp organized in the adopted villages with a specified theme given by Government of India by involving local youth. The special camp should be conducted only in the adopted village (for first year and second year NSS volunteers) at least for three years continuously

- Contribution to environmental awareness / protection
- Maximum efforts are being put to avoid all types of pollution.
- The institution conducts Green Audit annually. It aims to assess the level of energy conservation on the campus.
- Environmental awareness programmes and several competitions like Painting, Essay Writing and Quiz based on green themes.
- NSS in collaboration with ASAP organised the Environment Day Celebrations that promoted the green message through posters and theatrical performances.
- The college organised several seminars and lectures related to Environment Conservation, Eco-literacy, and Biodiversity Management etc.

- Cleanliness throughout the campus is maintained for which employees are recruited exclusively.

4. WATER CONSERVATION AND RAIN WATER HARVESTING

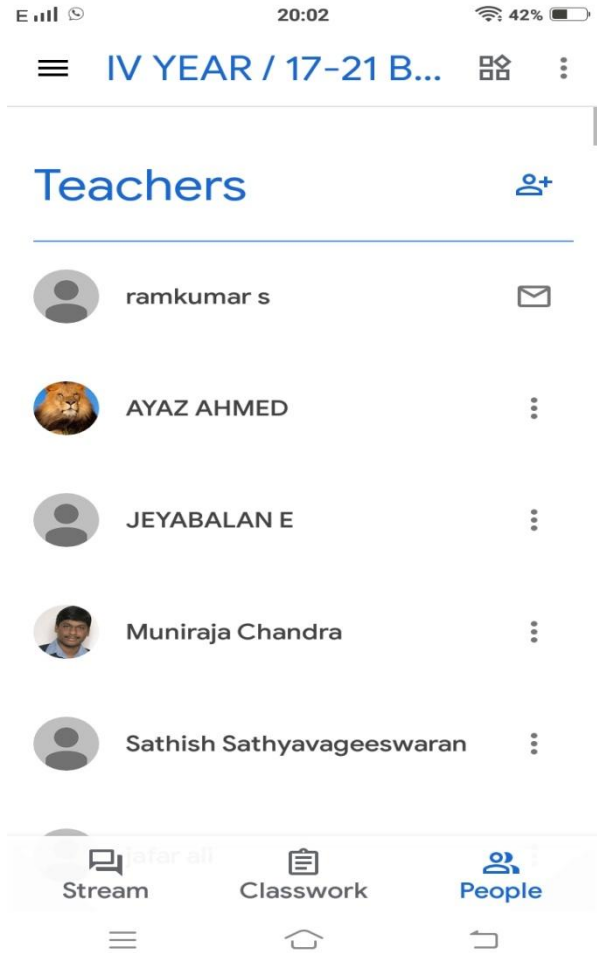
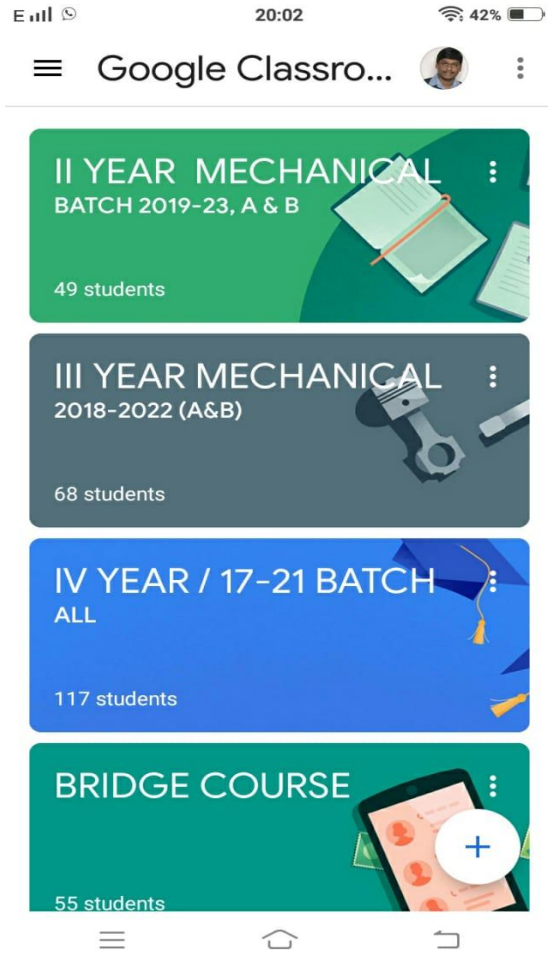
