

academic environment. Redressal mechanism was also discussed during the session.



The session was attended by more than 100 students. As ragging has become a menace, a cause of fear and shock for fresher in the country, it led to new law that curb ragging. Asso.Prof. Dr. k. Suresh Kumar discussed about the various punishments given in the case of ragging. Dr. k. Suresh Kumar highlighted the Honorable Supreme Court's Guidelines to be followed by universities, colleges and other educational institutes to curb ragging. He encouraged students how to participate in making ragging free campus respect to anti-ragging and the talk concluded with a call to 'Say no to Ragging'.

Objective of the awareness session:

- (1) Ragging's definition
- (2) To provide knowledge on "how to identify ragging activities" and role
- (3) To provide knowledge on how to file affidavit of anti Ragging.



Students were directed to follow the rules and regulations of the institution. To avoid ragging in the campus the following measures are adopted. Inside the campus an anti-ragging committee constituted to ensure compliance with the provisions of the regulations as well as the provisions of any law for the time being in force concerning ragging. An Anti-Ragging Committee is constituted to prevent ragging and related activities in the campus. The committee is requested to make maximum awareness about the UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and punishments. Students must submit anti-ragging related affidavits to the institution at the time of admission. Anti-ragging committee conducts surprise visits to the classrooms to check the activities of ragging if any and prevent them regularly. Boards and hoardings were put up around the campus to exhort the students not to indulge in ragging.



create awareness among the students and faculty members. The session was fruitful for the



An Anti-Ragging Committee is constituted to prevent ragging and related activities in the campus. The committee is requested to make maximum awareness about the UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and punishments. Students must submit anti-ragging related affidavits to the institution at the time of admission. Anti-ragging committee conducts surprise visits to the classrooms to check the activities of ragging if any and prevent them regularly. Boards and hoardings were put up around the campus to exhort the students not to indulge in ragging.





#### Preventive Measures:

- Awareness Programs: The committee discussed organizing workshops, seminars, and awareness drives, involving senior students to ensure the message reaches all corners of the campus.
- Posters and Signage: It was agreed to display more posters around the campus, especially in hostel areas, detailing the anti-ragging helpline numbers and consequences of ragging.

#### Reported Incidents:

No serious ragging incidents were reported during the meeting period.

#### **Future Initiatives:**

The committee proposed conducting surprise checks in hostels and common areas, and to have more frequent student counseling sessions for fostering a positive environment.

A suggestion was made to create a student peer support group that could act as a first point of contact for students feeling uncomfortable or threatened.

#### Action Items:

- To Conduct an Anti Ragging Awareness Program by Dr. K. Suresh Kumar, Associate Professor, Department of Science and Humanities on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2022 for the first year student's in APJ Abdul Kalam Auditorium.
- 2. Increase the visibility of anti-ragging posters across the campus.

**Conclusion:** The meeting concluded at 12.45 p.m by giving assurance that "our campus will be a Ragging free campus".
