NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME



SAY NO TO RAGGING!

“**RAGGING**” means display of noisy, disorderly conduct doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes.

- a) teasing, abusing or playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to such student or
- b) asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course willingly do.

PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING BY THE UNIVERSITY IF FOUND GUILTY

- Suspension from attending classes and/or academic privileges
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national and international meet, events, tournament, youth festival, etc
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Cancellation of admission
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the college will resort to collective punishment
- As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997, ragging is liable to be punished such as expulsion from the institution and/or rigorous imprisonment up to 3 years, and/or fine up to Rs. 25,000

SOFT SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME

Centre for Soft Skill Training Programme (C-SSTP) was started in the even semester of academic year 2017-2018 to give the training on English language and to strengthen the core subjects expertise through training on National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL). The C-SSTP mainly focuses training to our first and second year students of all engineering departments. Soft Skill Training Programme (SSTP) sessions training are given by our Faculty Members from six Engineering Departments and from English Department. SSTP consists of the following sessions.

- Seminar by the students – Students will be giving seminar on their interested topic using Power Point Presentation, animation and writing board effectively.
- Training and Awareness about IELTS – Introductory information about IELTS and Awareness about IELTS.
- Soft Skill Training – Students will be given training on Soft Skills by our English Language Faculty Members.

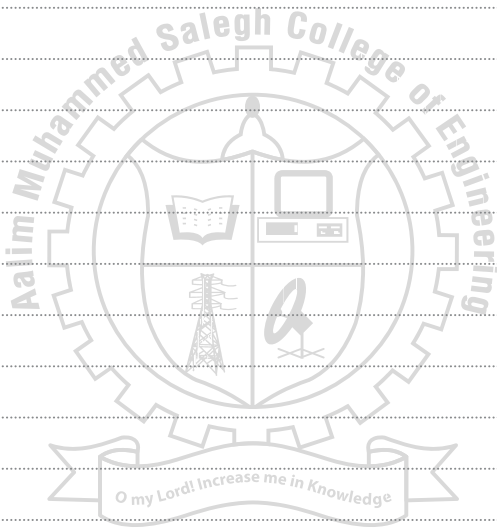
