Asking the Students to do any act or perform something which such Student will not in the ordinary course willingly do.



PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING

BY THE UNIVERSITY IF FOUND GUILTY

Suspension from attending classes and/or academic privileges

Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits



Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process

Withholding Results

Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national and international meet, events, tournament, youth festival, etc

Suspension/expulsion from the hostel

Cancellation of admission

Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters

Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the college will resort to collective punishment

As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997, ragging is liable to be punished such as expulsion from the institution and/or rigorous imprisonment up to 3 years, and/or fine up to Rs. 25,000
